

Fairness and Equalities Board

This board brings together private, public and voluntary sector representatives to work to create a fairer York. It is chaired by Dianne Willcocks CBE.

Sitting under the Without Walls Board it takes forward the principles previously set out by the Fairness Commission and aims to ensure that:

- York has good community relations and that people and groups get on well together;
- Equality of opportunity is increased and everyone can prosper and flourish;
- The city's workforce is reflective of our community.

The Board is now looking to fill three vacancies. The terms of reference for the board are attached. At present we are particularly seeking members who:

- ii. have a knowledge of and interest in tackling health inequalities, or
- iii. have a knowledge of and interest in tackling loneliness and social isolation
